



Members of the Pacific NW CSA Coalition enjoy the following benefits:

- **Listing on the www.pnwcsa.org website -- the most accurate CSA directory in the region.** Last year our directory received over 40,000 hits, with 10,000 new visitors looking for CSA farms for the first time.
- **Being part of the largest community of CSA Farmers in the Pacific NW**
Attend farm field trips, potlucks, and workshops. Connect with and learn from other farmers in the region.
- **Table at the annual CSA Share Fair**
Attended each year by over 1,200 people. Even if you're not in the Portland area, the publicity around this event builds momentum for signups in early March.
- **SNAP (formerly food stamps) payment processing**
In 2024, we processed over \$209,000 in SNAP for our member farms. 73 farms were enrolled in our program, serving over 650 families throughout Oregon. Our process does not require swiping a card and operates just like automatic bill pay. There is a small additional fee per customer for this service.
- **Double Up Food Bucks** incentive program participation. We will cover HALF the cost of the subscription to help your customers who pay with SNAP afford shares. Last year we were able to distribute \$185,000 of DUFBI incentives to our farmers on behalf of their members.
- **Matchmaking with Employers and Organizations**
Every year, the Coalition matches CSA farms with employers and organizations that want to host dropoff sites.
- **Promoting your CSA farm at events**
Have a presence at events where PNWCSA hosts a table.
- **Member services by Coalition volunteers**
We answer emails from the public, respond to media inquiries, play matchmaker for people who want to join a CSA, and educate about the benefits of CSA throughout the year.

Supporting CSA Farms also have the following responsibilities:

- **Make an annual donation of \$50-\$200 at [PNWCSA membership dues](#).**
Your annual donation is based on your 2024 gross CSA sales. Farms that sold less than \$50,000 should make a donation of at least \$50. Farms that sold over \$200,000 are encouraged, but not required, to donate more than \$200.
- **Support the Coalition by participating in fundraising events**
The Coalition is working hard to make the weekly delivery of fresh, local food available to everyone in our region because CSA changes eating habits and improves health. Give your members the opportunity to support our work.
- **Track and report referral sources.**
- **Help share and promote Coalition events to your members** via social media, newsletters, and other means.
